3. One aria
4. One musical theater or art song selection
5. One R&B/pop/rock or country selection
6. An a cappella performance of the *Star-Spangled Banner* in a key selected by the candidate

Applicants selected from screening of recordings will be invited for a personal interview and audition. Travel expenses will be paid by the United States Army. Military personnel must be eligible for permanent change of station and must submit an Intent to Release memorandum from their unit Commander and an Enlisted Records Brief (ERB) or equivalent.

Due to recent enlistment policy restrictions, prior service personnel are advised to consult with their local Army recruiter concerning eligibility.
