Perform as Jazz Trumpeter in the Jazz Ambassadors of The United States Army Field Band; Tour approximately 100 days per year in the U.S. and abroad; Support Educational Outreach Program in schools across the nation; Position requires a minimum 4-year enlistment — the candidate will be informed of acceptance prior to enlistment; Other duties as required in service to the organization

Email attachments are acceptable, however be advised that emails with large files attached may not be deliverable to our inbox, with no notification to the sender.
