BIOGRAPHY

Major Scott McKenzie was assigned as Associate Bandmaster of The U.S. Army Field Band and Officer-in-Charge of the Concert Band in August 2012. Previously, he was Commander of the United States Army Training and Doctrine Command Band at Fort Eustis, Virginia. Major McKenzie initially enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1999 and was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division Band at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. Upon earning his commission, he served at the Army School of Music, the United States Army Europe Band and Chorus, and The United States Army Band.

Major McKenzie earned a Master of Music degree in Composition from George Mason University, where he was a student of Dr. Glenn Smith and Mark Camhouse. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Music from Virginia Tech and studied music education and conducting at Old Dominion University and the Peabody Conservatory. Before enlisting in the Army, he taught band, chorus, and general music at the middle school level for four years.
