PRELIMINARY ROUND REPERTOIRE

1. MOZART *Clarinet Concerto in A Major*, Mvt. I, mm. 57-98.
2. BRAHMS *Symphony No. 3*, Mvt. II, beginning to 2 before rehearsal B.
3. GRAINGER *Lincolnshire Posy*, Mvt. IV, mm. 1-25
4. MENDELSSOHN *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, Scherzo, beginning to B.

OPTION 1: RECORDED PRELIMINARY ROUND

Deadline - April 11

1. Create digital, UNEDITED recordings in high-quality MP3 format. Each excerpt should be a separate file.

Please name the files as follows:

- 2_Brahms.mp3
- 3_Grainger.mp3
- 4_Mendelssohn.mp3

2. Upload files to a single folder in a cloud provider of your choice. Create a PUBLICLY VIEWABLE link to the folder and add the link in the body of an email. Do not send videos or include any identifying information in the recordings or folder.
3. Attach a recent resumé with your physical address, phone, email address, and two references in PDF format to the email with the recording links.

OPTION 2: LIVE PRELIMINARY ROUND

Deadline - June 1

1. No later than June 1, 2025, send a recent PDF resumé with your physical address, phone, email address, and two references to usarmyfieldbandauditions@army.mil.
2. The live preliminary round will take place at Fort Meade, MD on June 25, 2025. *All travel, lodging, and meals will be at applicant expense.*
